

How to Get rid of the login keyring password

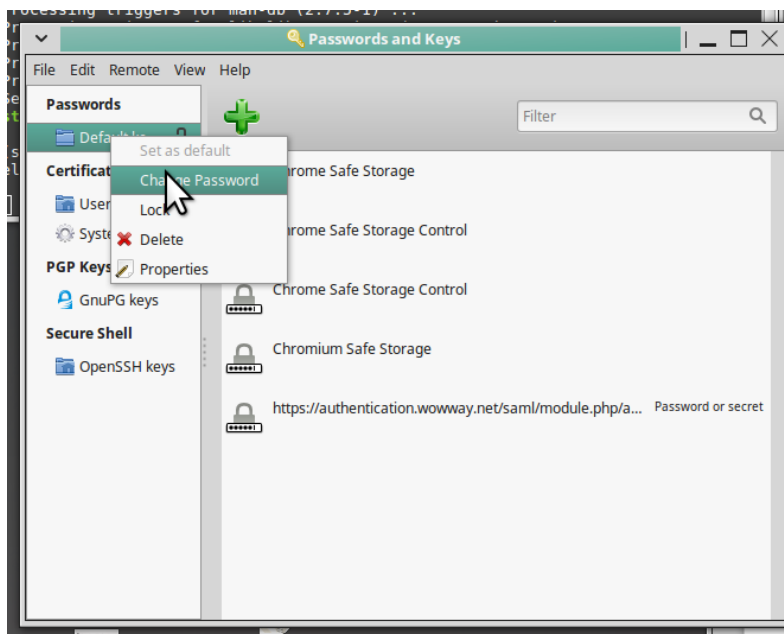


When we configure our account for login automatically, when booting we may be asked for our password for unlock the login keyring. If no one else uses your computer, this is useless, but it's really easy to remove:

First, search for "Passwords and Keys". If it cannot be found, open it from terminal:

seahorse

(If seahorse is not installed, in terminal type: `sudo apt install seahorse`)



Right- click at passwords Default and highlight change password.

Use your root password to open the change window. In that change window do not add a new password twice when prompted, then complete the change.

Also, the login keyring ask for the password if you have changed your user password. Doing this can fix that, just in the new password fields enter your new password.
